



# City of Pontiac Guide How & Where to VOTE 2020 Elections



**Early in Person:** You can vote in person with an absentee ballot at Pontiac City Clerk’s office now through **Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>**



**Absentee Ballot:** The deadline to return your application to request an absentee ballot is **Oct. 20<sup>th</sup>**.

**After Oct. 20<sup>th</sup>,** it is recommended you drop your absentee ballot at the Clerk’s office or one of the drop boxes. **It must be received by 8:00 pm on Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> and Postmarked by Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup>!!**
