Re: 2015 tax rates

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Immediately following the public hearing on **June 4, 2015** on the proposed budget and tax rates, City Council is requested to pass the following resolution to establish the tax rates for 2015 (regardless if the proposed 2015-16 budget amendments are approved):

*Whereas, pursuant to MCL 141.412 and 141.413, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget for the 2015-16 fiscal year was published in The Oakland Press, a newspaper of general circulation on Saturday, May 31, 2014 and a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on Thursday, June 5, 2014; and,*

*Whereas, pursuant to MCL 141.412 and 141.413, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget for the 2016-17 fiscal year was published in The Oakland Press, a newspaper of general circulation on Saturday, May 30, 2015 and a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on Thursday, June 4, 2015; and,*

*Whereas proposed budget amendments to the 2015-16 fiscal year were also under consideration at the June 4, 2015 meeting; and,*

*Whereas proposed tax rate to support the budget amendments to the 2015-16 fiscal year were also under consideration at the June 4, 2015 meeting;*

*Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the City Council causes to be levied and collected the general property tax on all real and personal property within the City upon the current tax roll an allocated millage of: General Operating 11.2737 mills; Capital Improvement – 1.4091 mills; Sanitation – 2.8183 mills; Senior Services - .5000 mills. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to impose a one percent (1%) property tax administration fee for all property taxes due, and a late penalty charge when applicable, in conformance with Section 44 of Public Act 206 of 1893.*
