

Permit Parking Notice

August 12, 2017 - 6 AM to 12 Midnight

To protect neighborhoods near the Pontiac Power Week Festival from traffic, parking congestion, noise and litter, on-street parking will be allowed on a PERMIT-ONLY basis between the hours of 6:00 A.M. Saturday, August 12th to 12:00 AM (Midnight) Sunday, August 13th. Please see the map below to determine if you reside within the parking permit area.

Pontiac residents living within the designated area noted below and park on the street must display the parking permit issued by the City of Pontiac. This parking permit must be displayed with the address visible through the windshield. To avoid being towed or ticketed, permit must be placed on the front, driver's side, corner of the vehicle's dashboard.

If you reside in an area where permanent permit parking restrictions are already in effect, those restrictions remain in effect. Vehicles that are parked in a permit parking only zone without a valid permit can be ticketed and/or towed at the Oakland County Sheriff's Office discretion.
