

The Hall-Scott aircraft **motors**, now made in Detroit, are standard power plants in the army planes of Japan, and other foreign governments are using them.

The Continental Motors Corporation builds a radial air-cooled aircraft motor, and in addition operates a private air line between their Detroit and Muskegon plants.

Captain Edward V. Rickenbacker is also building a radial air-cooled aircraft motor.

To encourage the aircraft industry, and in order that it may continue to locate in Detroit, a great airport is being constructed, which occupies the lower end of Grosse Ile. This site offers the finest location in the country around which aircraft manufacturers may locate. The Ford Airport at Dearborn is the most modern in the world. When completed, the Municipal Airport for the City of Detroit, which is located four and one-half miles from the downtown business district, will be the finest public flying field in the country.

The A-B-C Airline Corporation of Lansing, Michigan, founded by Talbert Abrams, its President, and the Kalec & Forster Company, Hofman Building, Detroit, are said to be the oldest and largest commercial aero-photography concerns in the United States.

ADDING MACHINES

The largest adding machine plant in the world is in Detroit. Michigan leads in the manufacture of adding and calculating machines.

MOTOR TRUCKS AND TRACTORS

Michigan leads the world in the manufacture of motor trucks and tractors. The largest tractor plant, the Fordson, is located in Detroit. The largest truck factory, the General Motors Truck, is at Pontiac.

PONTIAC is the third fastest growing city in the State, with a population of 57,000. This city has an annual payroll of over \$24,000,000. Some of the more important products manufactured here, in addition to trucks, are: radios, radio accessories, varnishes, paints, gas engines, gray iron castings, automobile bodies, automotive tools and automobiles. Here is the home of the Oakland and Pontiac Six automobiles.

Pontiac is twenty-six miles north of Detroit. and these two

cities are connected by Woodward Avenue, now the world's greatest highway. The city is located in a section of the State rich in Indian lore. It has taken its name from one of the most famous of them all-Pontiac, Chief of the Ottawas.

AUTOMOBILES

Flint is the second automobile city in the world.

FLINT: This city is known far and wide as "the Vehicle City," and at one time was the world leader in the carriage and wagon industry. With the advent of the automobile, its manufacturers were quick to recognize the great future of the automobile industry. Flint has a higher percentage of population employed in factories than any other city in the United States. Upwards of 48,000 people draw an annual payroll of approximately \$70,000,000.

Flint is now the fastest growing city in the country. The population is 161,347, an increase of over 600% within the last seventeen years. Within the next two years Flint must build 20,000 new homes to care for its rapid increase in population-10,000 of these homes are needed immediately. New industries continue to locate here. The most recent arrival is the Fisher Body Company, the largest automobile body manufacturers in the world.
