

Wanted: City of Pontiac Planning Commissioners

The City of Pontiac is seeking to appoint seven individuals to the Planning Commission in accordance with Public Act 110 of 2006, the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act and Public Act 33 of 2008, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act.

Qualified candidates will be representative of and have relevant experience in important segments of the Pontiac community, such as the economic, governmental, educational, and social development sectors of the City, in accordance with the major interests as they exist in Pontiac, such as education, public health, government, transportation, industry, commerce, natural resources, and recreation and be representative of the City of Pontiac.

Planning Commissioners must attend monthly meetings of the Pontiac Planning Commission held at 6:30 p.m. on the first Wednesday of every month in City Hall. Applicants are required to complete 10 hours of Planning Commissioner training provided by the City of Pontiac within 30 days of appointment. Planning Commissioners are also required to complete 10 hours of additional training each year.

The City is soliciting applications from qualified candidates to be considered for appointment to the Planning Commission. The deadline for application is June 30, 2011.
