ORDER NO. S-324

RE: Appointments to various boards and commissions

The Local Financial Stability and Choice Act (Act 436 of 2012/MCL 141.15411, et. seq.) in Section 10 empowers an Emergency Manager to issue orders to the appropriate local elected and appointed officials and employees, agents, and contractors of the local government a Manager considers necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Act and any such orders are binding on the local elected and appointed officials and employees, agents, and contractors of the local government to whom they are issued.

Section 12(1) of the Act provides that “[a]n emergency manager may take 1 or more of the following additional actions with respect to a local government that is in receivership, notwithstanding any charter provision to the contrary: “(ff) Remove, replace, appoint, or confirm the appointments to any office, board, commission, authority, or other entity which is within or is a component unit of the local government.”

It is hereby ordered:


1. That the following individuals are appointed to the respective boards and commission to such terms as indicated:

- Leon Jukowski, Tax Increment Finance Authority, term expiring February 24, 2017.
- William Mayfield, Housing Commission, term expiring January 24, 2018.
- Jeffrey Scott, Construction Code Board of Appeals, term expiring March 1, 2016.
- Jeffrey Scott, Hearing Officer (second hearing officer).
- Linda Porter, Historic District Commission, term expiring July 19, 2014 (replace seat declined by Ron Gay).
- Tameka Ramsey, Historic District Commission, term expiring July 19, 2014 (replace seat declined by John Cohassey).

The Order shall have immediate effect.

This order is effective as indicated and is necessary to carry out the duties and responsibilities required of the Emergency Manager as set forth in the Local Financial Stability and Choice Act (Act 436 of 2012/MCL 141.15411, et. seq.) and the contract between the Local Emergency Financial Assistance Loan Board and the Emergency Manager.
