

The City of Pontiac's Water and Sewer Rates Will be Increased Overall By 10% For The Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2005. This Increase Is Due To The Cost of Purchased Water From The City Of Detroit And The Operations And Maintenance Of The Pontiac Water, Sewer, And Wastewater Divisions.

The Current Senior Citizen Discount of 10% Will Remain in Effect for Those 65 Years Of Age And Older For Their Primary Residence, After Making Applications Annually Through the Water Billing Staff Located At the City Treasurer's Office, City Hall, 1st Floor, Pontiac, MI 48342.

SENIOR DISCOUNT PROGRAM
