A public hearing to present the applications received for Fiscal Year 2010 Community Development Block Grant funding will be held Monday, February 1, 2010 in the Pontiac City Hall Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. This hearing, as required by Federal guidelines and established in the FY2005 - 2010 Consolidated Planning Timeline, will provide Pontiac citizens an opportunity to express their views on the allocation of funds for Fiscal Year 2010.

All CDBG-funded projects and activities must either 1) principally benefit low-moderate income persons; 2) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight; or 3) meet other Community Development needs having a particular urgency.

The City of Pontiac will receive approximately \$1,525,296 in Community Development Block Grant funds. As of the date of this posting, final figures have not been received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Fiscal Year 2010. The allocations listed above will be adjusted slightly to conform to the final funding received from HUD.

This public hearing will also request public comment on two (2) supplemental grants received by the City of Pontiac: Supplemental FY'08 Funding for the CDBG Program from the Recovery Act (\$414,121) and Supplemental FY'08 Funding for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 1 (\$3,542,002).

The Supplemental FY'08 Funding for the CDBG Program will be used for a Special Street Resurfacing Project. These funds will provide the resurfacing of Madison Street, between Joslyn Avenue and Arlene Street.

The Neighborhood Stabilization Program 1 is being changed to put more focus on acquisition/rehabilitation-resale and demolition.

Public comment on all three programs discussed at this Public Hearing is invited by the Federal Programs Division. A 15-day public comment period on the CDBG-R and NSP1 program will end at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 16, 2010. A 30-day public comment period on the applications for FY'10 CDBG funding will end at 5 p.m. at Wednesday, March 3, 2010.
