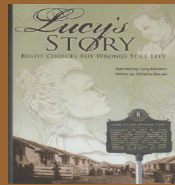
28 HEROES

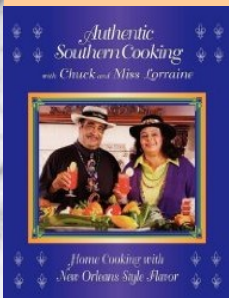

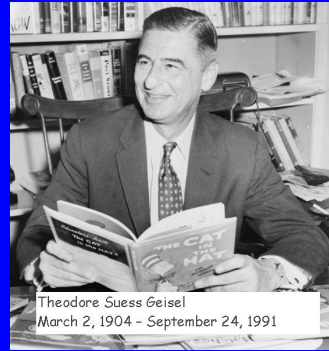
