PUBLIC HEARING RELATIVE TO DRINKING WATER REVOLVING FUND

2010 WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the **City of Pontiac** will hold a public hearing on the proposed Water System Improvements to be funded by the State of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Drinking Water Revolving Fund (DWRf) Low Interest Loan program for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve water system reliability, efficiency, safety, security, water quality and ease of operation as well as decreased operation costs. Construction will include the following components: 1. South Opdyke pumping station rehabilitation; 2. Updating controls and monitoring at two emergency well sites, PRV pit at Walton and Giddings, and Montcalm elevated storage tank. 3. Replacement of inoperable air-relief valves and large diameter butterfly valves on transmission mains. 4. Water main replacement and installation at specific locations required for system looping.

The total estimated cost for the work is \$9,500,000 to be paid over a 20-year period with a State of Michigan Low Interest Loan. The discounted rate is 2.5% and will be funded by water system revenues.

Copies of the Project Plan will be available for public viewing March 6, 2009 at the City of Pontiac Department of Public Works and Utilities Office at 522 South Opdyke Road.
