A public hearing to present the allocations for Fiscal Year 2010 Community Development Block Grant and HOME Program funding will be held Monday, April 12, 2010 in the Pontiac City Hall Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. This hearing, as required by Federal guidelines and established in the FY2005 - 2010 Consolidated Planning Timeline, will provide Pontiac citizens an opportunity to express their views on the allocation of funds for Fiscal Year 2010.

All CDBG-funded projects and activities must either 1) principally benefit low-moderate income persons; 2) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight; or 3) meet other Community Development needs having a particular urgency.

Funding allocations will be presented at the Public Hearing. Applications for FY2010 funding are:

The City of Pontiac will receive approximately \$1,693,949 in Community Development Block Grant funds and \$591,237 in HOME Program funding..

Public comment on the allocations and the draft of the 2010 Annual Plan discussed at this Public Hearing is invited by the Federal Programs Division. A 30-day public comment period on the allocations and Annual Plan will end at 5 p.m. at Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
