NOTE: No turns from Huron to Southbound Saginaw St. from Sat., Aug. 17 at 8:00 am through 11:00 pm.

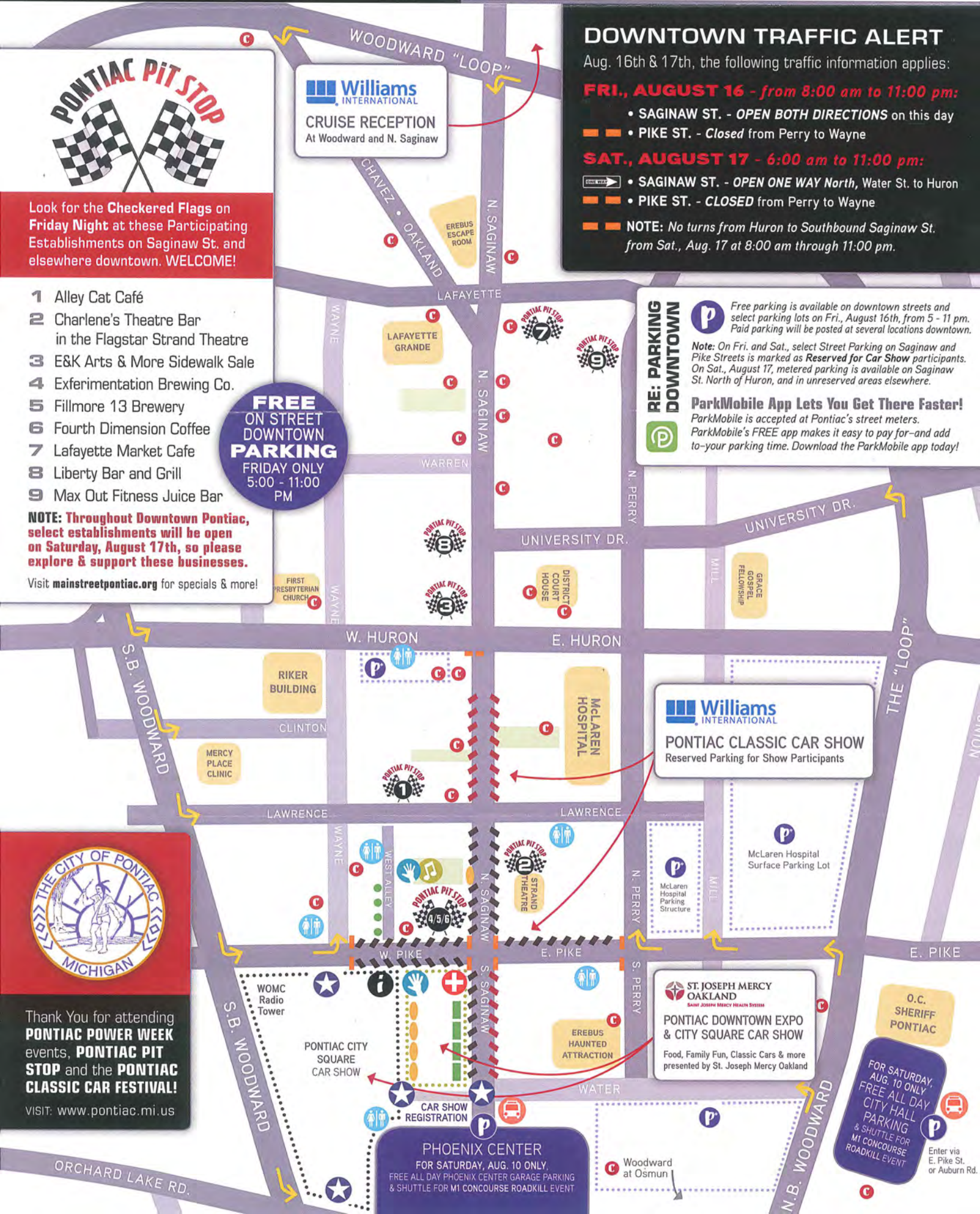
RE: PARKING DOWNTOWN
